2. Metadata

- Phone numbers, email addresses and usernames
- Location data: where your mobile phone is
- Date- and time-stamps on phone calls, emails, files, and photos.
- Information about the device you are using
- The subject lines of your emails

How much control do you have over your data?

Bruce Schneier has put forward a useful framework which stratifies types of data into 6 levels, each of which corresponds to a different degree of control. In short, these are:

- SERVICE DATA - data you provide in exchange for a certain service
- DISCLOSED DATA - data posted to a platform you control
- ENTRUSTED DATA - data posted to a platform someone else controls
- INCIDENTAL DATA - data created by others about you
- BEHAVIORAL DATA - data created through our usage of a mobile phone or a computer.
- DERIVED DATA - data about us that's inferred from other data.
